1 I, Jay Kerley, declare as follows:

2 1. I respectfully submit this declaration in support of final approval of the proposed
3 settlement of the above-captioned class action (the "Settlement"). I also submit this declaration in
4 support of my request for reimbursement of \$985.00 for time spent and expenses incurred in carrying
5 out my responsibilities to the Class. I have personal knowledge of the statements herein, and if called
6 as a witness, could competently testify thereto.

7 2. After consultation with legal counsel, I made the decision to become involved in this
8 action as a named Plaintiff and understood my responsibility to serve the best interests of the Class. To
9 that end, I consulted with Plaintiffs' counsel and engaged in meetings and communications with counsel
10 regarding the litigation; reviewed pleadings and memoranda filed by counsel; reviewed and provided
11 relevant documents to my counsel; consulted with my counsel and provided input regarding litigation
12 and settlement strategy; and consulted with my counsel regarding the mediation and settlement
13 negotiations that resulted in the Settlement.


14 3. I authorized Plaintiffs' counsel to settle this action. In making the determination that the
15 settlement represented a fair, reasonable and adequate result for the Class, I weighed the substantial
16 benefits to the Class against the significant risks and uncertainties of continued litigation. After doing
17 so, I believe that the Settlement represents a highly favorable recovery, and believe that final approval
18 of the Settlement is in the best interest of the Class.

19 4. I understand the Court may make an award of reasonable costs and expenses directly
20 relating to the representation of the Class to representatives serving on behalf of the Class. I am
21 requesting the amount of \$985.00 in connection with my representation of the Class and my assistance
22 with the litigation. This request is based on the conservative estimate that I devoted approximately
23 5 hours to litigation related activities described above at a reasonable hourly rate of \$197. This hourly
24 rate is based on the following: I am a senior executive at a large publicly-traded company, and the base
25 salary range of someone in a similar or commensurate position as me is approximately \$410,000 -
26 \$450,000. Converting the lower end of that salary range to an hourly rate based on a 40-hour work
27 week yields \$197. Then, multiplying that hourly rate by the 5 hours I spent on litigation-related
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1 activities yields \$985. The hours spent on this case was time that I would have otherwise devoted to
2 other professional activities.

3 I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed this 26th day
