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1 I, Warren Schneider, declare as follows:

2 1. I respectfully submit this declaration in support of final approval of the settlement of the
3 above-captioned action for \$7,500,000 (the "Settlement"). I also submit this declaration in support of
4 my request for reimbursement of \$1,000.00 for time spent in carrying out my responsibilities to the
5 Class. I have personal knowledge of the statements herein, and if called as a witness, could
6 competently testify thereto.

7 2. After consultation with legal counsel, I made the decision to become involved in this
8 action as a named Plaintiff and understood my responsibility to serve the best interests of the Class.

9 3. In order to fulfill my responsibilities as a named Plaintiff, I was in regular
10 communication with the attorneys at Scott+Scott, Attorneys at Law, LLP ("Scott+Scott"), co-lead
11 counsel for plaintiffs in this action. Through my active and continuous involvement, I closely
12 supervised, carefully monitored, and was actively involved in the material aspects of the prosecution of
13 this action. I received periodic status updates on case developments, and participated in regular
14 discussion with attorneys from Scott+Scott concerning the prosecution of the action, the strengths and
15 risks of the claims, and potential settlement. In particular, throughout the course of the Action, I: (a)
16 consulted regularly with Scott+Scott attorneys regarding the posture and progress of the case; (b)
17 reviewed significant pleadings and briefs filed in the action; (c) reviewed the Court's orders and
18 discussed them with counsel; (d) consulted with counsel regarding the mediation and settlement
19 negotiations; and (e) evaluated and approved the proposed Settlement.

20 4. I authorized Plaintiffs' counsel to settle this action. In making the determination that the
21 settlement represented a fair, reasonable and adequate result for the Class, I weighed the substantial
22 benefits to the Class against the significant risks and uncertainties of continued litigation. After doing
23 so, I believe that the Settlement represents a highly favorable recovery, and believe that final approval
24 of the Settlement is in the best interest of the Class.


25 5. I understand the Court may make an award of reasonable costs and expenses directly
26 relating to the representation of the Class to any representative serving on behalf of the Class. I
27 understand that the Court has discretion to grant in full or in part, or to deny my request for
28 reimbursement. I was promised and expected no reimbursement for serving as a representative plaintiff

1 in this action, but due to my participating in a multi-million dollar recovery for the Class, I believe the
2 modest reimbursement is warranted.

3 6. I am requesting the amount of \$1,000 in connection with my representation of the Class.
4 This request is based on the conservative estimate that I devoted approximately 15-20 hours to litigation
5 related activities described above. The hours spent on this case was time that I would have otherwise
6 devoted to other personal or professional activities.
